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IHCP to enhance security on the Provider Healthcare Portal

Effective February 28, 2019, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will add a new security feature on the IHCP Provider Healthcare Portal (Portal) to protect against unauthorized scripting activity by automated software, commonly known as web robots or bots. Automated scripting activity on the Portal is prohibited.

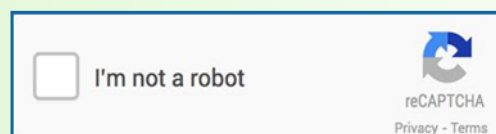
Figure 1 – reCAPTCHA protection badge

The new feature is a reCAPTCHA (Completely Automated Public Turing Test To Tell Computers and Humans Apart) tool that requires users to solve various security challenges to confirm the user is not automated software. The new feature will be employed at login, when the user navigates to the *Registration* page and, as warranted on the Eligibility Verification Request panel. The reCAPTCHA protection badge will display (see Figure 1).

As a reminder, providers that want to exchange **eligibility transactions using an automated method must be a trading partner with the IHCP and should submit the real-time 270/271 Health Care Eligibility Benefit Inquiry and Response transactions**.

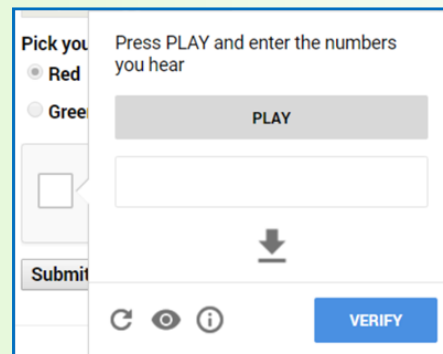
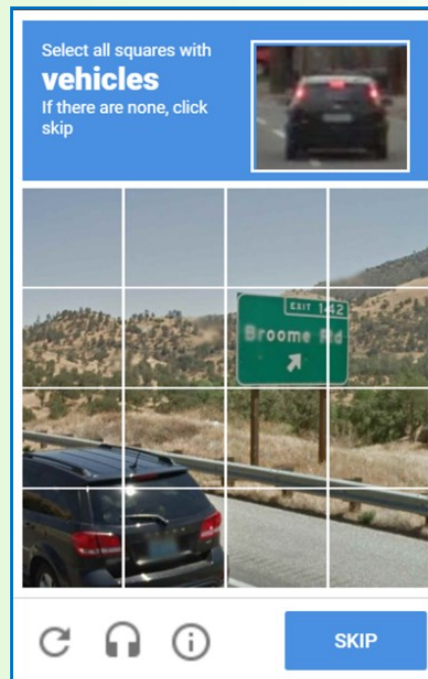
Figure 2 – reCAPTCHA check box challenge

Examples of the security challenges include the check box challenge (see Figure 2), the text challenge (see [Figure 3](#)), the audio challenge (see [Figure 4](#)), and the image challenge (see [Figure 5](#)). If suspicious automated scripting activity is detected or the user's identity cannot be confirmed, the user will be required to provide additional verification by solving additional challenges. The user will not be granted access to the Portal until the challenges have been successfully solved.

New program integrity behavioral health and ABA documentation guidelines now available

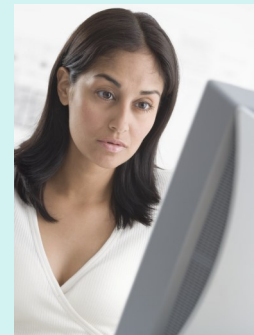
