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## IHCP to mass reprocess or mass adjust claims for HCPCS code J2796 that denied incorrectly

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) identified a claim-processing issue that affects certain fee-for-service (FFS) claims for Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code J2796 – *Injection, romiplostim, 10 micrograms* billed with National Drug Code (NDC) 55513-0223-01. Claims with dates of service (DOS) from November 22, 2019, through March 9, 2021, may have denied incorrectly with explanation of benefits (EOB) 4300 – *Invalid NDC to procedure code combination*.

The claim-processing system has been corrected. Claims or claim details processed during the indicated time frame for code J2796 that denied for EOB 4300 will be mass reprocessed or mass adjusted, as appropriate. Providers should see reprocessed or adjusted claims on Remittance Advices (RAs) beginning April 13, 2021, with internal control numbers (ICNs)/Claim IDs that begin with 80 (reprocessed denied claims) or 52 (mass replacements non-check related).



## Reimbursement updates for certain COVID-19 laboratory procedure codes

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is updating reimbursement for the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes in [Table 1](#), which are laboratory procedure codes associated with testing for the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). The updates are based on pricing information from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and differ from the reimbursement information previously announced in IHCP bulletins [BT202093](#), [BT2020110](#), and [BT2020119](#). The changes to pricing will be effective for claims with dates of service (DOS) on or after April 9, 2021.



*Note: The revised procedure code linkages to revenue codes in [Table 1](#) are effective retroactively to January 1, 2021. All other billing guidance published in the previous IHCP bulletins remains unchanged.*

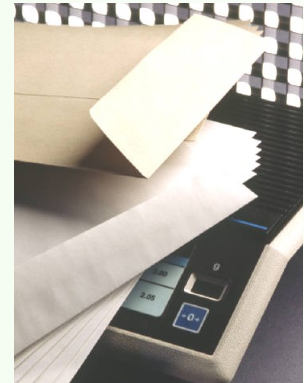

## Gainwell Technologies post office mailing addresses update

With the recent transition of DXC Technology to Gainwell Technologies, as announced in *Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) Banner Page BR202042*, updated post office mailbox addresses are now available.

Providers and business entities should use the new Gainwell Technologies mailbox addresses that became effective February 1, 2021. Mail addressed to DXC will continue to be delivered to Gainwell Technologies through July 31, 2021. However, after that date mail addressed to DXC may be returned to the sender by the U.S. Postal Service carrier.
