Providers can submit meaningful use attestations for Program Year 2021, beginning May 3, 2021

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) participates in the federal Promoting Interoperability (PI) Program to provide incentives for eligible professionals and hospitals to adopt, implement, upgrade (AIU), or demonstrate meaningful use (MU) of certified electronic health records (EHR) technology.

Beginning May 3, 2021, the Indiana Medicaid Promoting Interoperability Program will accept Program Year 2021 MU attestations from eligible professionals (EPs), eligible hospitals (EHs), and critical access hospitals (CAHs). Providers can submit attestations using the Medical Assistance Provider Incentive Repository (MAPIR) payment system through the IHCP Provider Healthcare Portal (Portal).

The last day to submit Program Year 2021 attestations is Sunday October 31, 2021.

Note: The Indiana Medicaid Promoting Interoperability (PI) Program was formerly known as the Electronic Health Records Incentive Program.

IHCP end dates Family Supports Waiver activity therapy service, H2032 U7 U5

Effective retroactively to September 30, 2009, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has end dated the Division of Disability and Rehabilitative Services (DDRS) Bureau of Developmental Disabilities Services (BDDS) Family Supports Waiver (FSW) procedure code and modifier combination for activity therapy service, H2032 U7 U5.

This procedure code and modifier combination was overlooked when changes were made to services during 2009, and now is end dated in the CoreMMIS claim-processing system. This update does not affect past claims or current services.

This change will be reflected in the next regular update to the Professional Fee Schedule, accessible from the IHCP Fee Schedules page at in.gov/medicaid/providers.
