EHR Attestations to Be Temporarily Suspended Due to Transition to *Core*MMIS and the Portal



On December 5, 2016, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will replace its current information management system, Indiana*AIM*, with the new *Core*MMIS, which stands for Core Medicaid Management Information System. Along with *Core*MMIS, a new provider interface called the Provider Healthcare Portal (Portal) will replace Web interChange.

To ensure a successful transition to the new system, the IHCP will temporarily suspend acceptance of all Electronic Health Records (EHR)

attestations. This is necessary to ensure that processing of attestations in the current system can be finalized and information can be converted to the new system. Access to the Medical Assistance Provider Incentive Repository (MAPIR) will be available in the current system through Thursday, November 17, 2016, and will be available via the new Portal beginning Monday, December 12, 2016.

What This Means For You

If you are an eligible professional (EP), eligible hospital (EH), or critical access hospital (CAH) and wish to submit a program year 2016 (PY 2016) adopt, implement, upgrade (AIU) or meaningful use (MU) application before the conversion to *Core*MMIS, you must do so by Thursday, November 17, 2016. PY 2016 AIU and MU applications not submitted by that date should be held for submission on or after Monday, December 12, 2016.
