INDIANA HEALTH COVERAGE PROGRAMS BT201756 AUGUST 29, 2017

Updates to the Preferred Diabetic Supply List

The *Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) Bulletin* [BT201684](#), dated December 1, 2016, notified providers that the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) selected Abbott Diabetes Care, Roche Diabetes Care, and Trividia Health as preferred vendors to supply blood glucose monitors and diabetes test strips to all IHCP programs, subject to limitations established for certain benefit packages. A list of the preferred diabetes supplies was published in that bulletin.

Effective September 1, 2017, the ACCU-CHEK® Guide Meter and corresponding test strips from Roche will be added to the previously published Preferred Diabetic Supply List (PDSL). Table 1 provides an updated list of all products on the PDSL, effective for dates of service (DOS) on or after September 1, 2017.

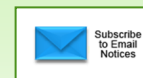
