

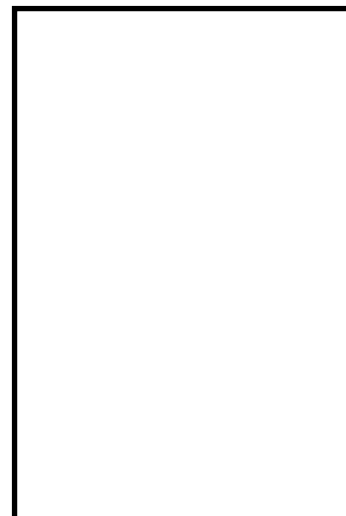

IHCP clarifies enrollment and billing requirements for newly added behavioral health professionals

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) recently began enrolling additional behavioral health professionals, as announced in *IHCP Bulletin BT2020108*. The IHCP is issuing additional clarification on enrollment and billing requirements for these providers:

- Providers wishing to enroll as a provider specialty 617 – *Licensed Independent Practice School Psychologist* are required to include documentation showing the individual maintaining an Independent Practice Endorsement (IPE) in addition to the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) School Services license as an Initial, Proficient, or Accomplished Practitioner.
- For billing purposes, if an independent practice school psychologist or other behavioral health professional identified in *BT2020108* is employed by a school corporation that provides covered Individualized Education Program (IEP) services, claims must be billed using the enrolled school corporation’s National Provider Identifier (NPI). The behavioral health professional should not be identified on the claim.



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
