IHCP to continue EVV post and pay

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will delay claim denials and allow electronic visit verification (EVV)-related claim edits to remain as post and pay after January 1, 2021. Providers will continue to see the explanation of benefits (EOB) statements indicating whether an EVVrelated claim was located with a submitted claim.



The 21st Century Cures Act directs Medicaid programs to require personal care service and home health service providers to use an EVV system to document services rendered. See *IHCP Bulletin* <u>BT201855</u> for more

information. The implementation date for requiring the use of an EVV system for personal care services was delayed to January 1, 2021. The implementation date for requiring the use of an EVV system for home health services remains January 1, 2023.

Providers are **still required** to begin submitting EVV records for personal care services for dates of service (DOS) on and after January 1, 2021. Providers that fail to submit EVV records as required are subject to post-payment review and payment recoupment.

Providers should monitor future IHCP publications for continued EVV-related and claim processing updates.
