Copays no longer required for tobacco cessation drugs

Effective retroactively for dates of services (DOS) on or after **February 1, 2020**, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) no longer requires copayments for tobacco cessation drugs. Providers should not collect copayments for these drugs. For copayments already collected for DOS on or after February 1, 2020, the member can pursue a refund from the pharmacy provider.



Tobacco cessation drugs exempt for copayment include, but may not be limited to, varenicline, bupropion for tobacco cessation, and nicotine replacement therapies. Preferred Drug List (PDL) and utilization management edits may still

apply for tobacco cessation drugs. Note: This change is unrelated to the temporary suspension of all drug copays previously announced in IHCP Bulletin <u>BT202044</u>.

The fee-for-service (FFS) PDL and prior authorization (PA) criteria can be found on the OptumRx Indiana Medicaid website, accessible via the <u>Pharmacy Services</u> page at in.gov/medicaid/providers.
