IHCP COVID-19 Response: IHCP announces temporary provider enrollment recertification change

In response to the ongoing coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) is implementing an additional temporary change to provider enrollment procedures.

Providers that are required to update their license, certification, or insurance between March 1, 2020, and the end of the State emergency declaration will now be required to update their certification after the conclusion of the emergency declaration. Enrollments that were terminated since March 1, 2020, due to failure to recertify will be reactivated and will be required to recertify after the conclusion of the emergency declaration. Providers will be notified of a new due date to submit their updated certification and will have at least 30 days from the notification to recertify.
