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## **2022 IHCP Works annual seminar scheduled for October 11-13 in Indianapolis**

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) and Gainwell Technologies invite Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) providers to attend the 2022 IHCP Works annual provider seminar. The in-person seminar begins Tuesday, October 11, and continues through Thursday, October 13. There is no cost for the seminar.

The seminar features three full days of valuable information. Topics include program overviews and specific program billing guidelines, as well as other important IHCP information. Sessions will be led by the FSSA, Anthem, CareSource, Managed Health Services (MHS), MDwise, UnitedHealthcare and Gainwell Technologies. ### **Seminar registration**

The registration page provides instructions, including the [Workshop Registration Tool Quick Reference Guide](#). Registration for the IHCP Works annual provider seminar is a two-step process. During registration, you must first register for the seminar. After you have confirmed your registration, you must then register for each session you would like to attend. When providers register, they receive a registration confirmation immediately.

Providers are advised to print paper copies of each presentation for reference, if desired. **Paper copies of the presentations will *not* be provided at the seminar.**

Walk-in registrations will be allowed; however, it is not recommended, as space is limited. The most popular sessions reach capacity well before the start of the seminar. Walk-in registrants will be allowed to attend sessions only if space is available.

Business casual attire is recommended for comfort. Consider layering to accommodate variations in room temperature. Beverage service will not be available; however, a restaurant, early morning coffee bar and snack shop are available at the facility where drinks, snacks and lunch can be purchased.

**Note: Please do not call the hotel to register for seminar sessions.**

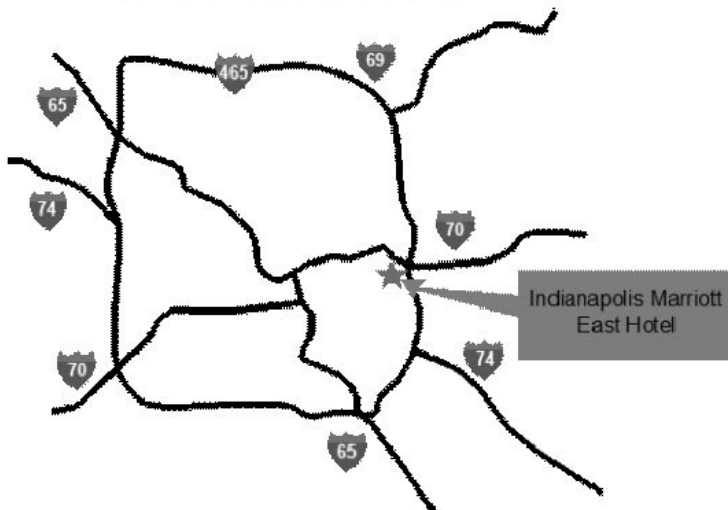

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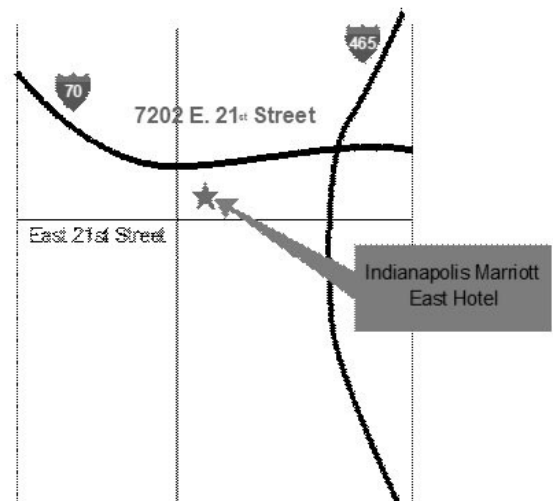

## Session Descriptions and Schedule

### Session Descriptions

Session Name	Description
<b>Behavioral Health</b> (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations give information on the claim submission process for behavioral health services. Topics will include common denial reasons and how to avoid them.
<b>Enrollment</b> (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations give information on the enrollment and revalidation processes with a focus on resolving common errors quickly and efficiently.
<b>Institutional Claims (UB-04)</b> (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations give information on the claim submission process using the online portals for institution-based services.
<b>Prior Authorization 101</b> (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	Each partner will present the basics of prior authorization (PA), including requirements, submission methods and provider recourse when a PA is denied. Each presentation may vary slightly.
<b>Prior Authorization 201</b> (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations look more closely at specific prior authorization situations, such as retro-authorizations and new births. A more detailed look at appeals and disputes is included.
<b>Professional Claims (CMS-1500)</b> (Presented by Anthem, CareSource, MDwise, MHS, UnitedHealthcare, Gainwell Technologies)	These presentations give information on the claim submission process using the online portals for professional services.
<b>Anthem – Integrated Care Model/Whole Person Care Approach</b>	This presentation on Anthem's Integrated Care Model and Whole Person Care Approach focuses on what "whole health" is, how to recognize integrated behavioral health and who can benefit from this program.
<b>CareSource – LGBTQ+ 101 and Our Healthcare Community</b>	Presented by Indiana Youth Group, this presentation discusses the health disparities experienced by LGBTQ+ youth and how providers can create and support a diverse and inclusive environment.
<b>MHS – Member Benefits and Care Management Programs</b>	This presentation gives information on benefits that Managed Health Services (MHS) members can access and how MHS Care Coordination and Disease Management programs assist members and providers.
<b>MDwise – Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services (CLAS)</b>	MDwise presents an introduction to its Culturally and Linguistically Appropriate Services (CLAS), including how CLAS can be used in services to reduce health disparities.
<b>UnitedHealthcare – Provider Portal/Community Care</b>	This session presents an introduction to how the UnitedHealthcare Provider Portal allows providers to check member eligibility, claim status, prior authorization status and various other functions.
<b>Gainwell – EVV Pitfalls and Prevention</b>	This session focuses on key problems that providers face around electronic visit verification (EVV) implementation and how to avoid those mistakes.
<b>Gainwell – Claim Research: Remittance Advice Versus Portal</b>	This session provides a comparison between your Remittance Advice and your claims as seen on the provider portal. Presentation also includes a discussion on how to find information in both.

<b>FSSA and Gainwell – EVV Policy Update</b>	FSSA and Gainwell Technologies provide key updates for successful implementation of electronic visit verification (EVV) for both personal care and home health services.
<b>FSSA – Keynote: Dr. Dan Rusyniak</b>	Secretary of the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA), Dr. Dan Rusyniak, gives a message of welcome to the IHCP Works seminar and provides highlights to the Indiana Medicaid programs.
<b>FSSA – Reviewing Box 33a Requirements</b>	FSSA will review professional claim requirements for Box 33a. This is one of the largest claim denial or rejection reasons for managed care claims.
<b>FSSA Telehealth</b>	This session presents a discussion about the evolution of telehealth services and the latest updates made to improve and increase access to the telehealth delivery system.
<b>FSSA – mLTSS</b>	FSSA will discuss upcoming managed long-term services and supports (mLTSS) changes including how day-to-day operations will change for Home- and Community-Based Services (HCBS) LTSS providers and how providers can best prepare and ready themselves for these changes.
<b>FSSA – PHE Return to Normal</b>	FSSA will provide information about the “Return to Normal” following the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency with a focus on the upcoming changes to member eligibility and its impact on IHCP providers.
<b>FSSA – SNF HIP Reimbursement Changes</b>	FSSA’s Reimbursement team will provide detailed information about Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) reimbursement changes for skilled nursing facilities taking effect on Nov. 1, 2022.
<b>FSSA – Medicaid Questions</b>	Modeled after the internet game sensation, Medicaid Questions (MQ) provides a fun, exciting way to test your knowledge of Medicaid policies.
