The IHCP Does Not Cover HCPCS Codes G0409, G0410, and G0411

Effective November 1, 2009, the Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) determined that Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) procedure codes G0409, G0410, and G0411 are not covered services and will not be reimbursed by the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP). The descriptions of these codes are as follows:

Table 1 – Partial Hospitalization HCPCS Codes Not Covered by the IHCP

HCPCS Code	Description
G0409	Social work and psychological services, directly relating to and/or furthering the patient's rehabilitation goals, each 15 minutes, face-to-face; individual (services provided by a CORF-qualified social worker or psychologist in a CORF)
G0410	Group psychotherapy other than of a multiple family group, in a partial hospitalization setting, approximately 45 to 50 minutes
G0411	Interactive group psychotherapy, in a partial hospitalization setting, approximately 45 to 50 minutes

These HCPCS codes are considered partial hospitalization and therefore, are only reimbursable by the Indiana Medicaid program when in accordance with *405 IAC 5-21*.

Mental Health Quality Advisory Committee Utilization Edits

On June 19, 2007, the Mental Health Quality Advisory Committee (MHQAC) recommended utilization edits for mental health medications, and these edits were then implemented (refer to provider bulletin *BT200709*, dated May 3, 2007) by the IHCP. The utilization edits are reviewed quarterly, and the additions in Table 2 are effective April 15, 2010. These updates were approved at the Quarter One 2010 MHQAC meeting and at the February 2010 Drug Utilization Review (DUR) Board meeting.
