HP to mass adjust dental claims

With the implementation of the 5 percent rate reduction for dental services that went into effect on April 1, 2010, HP inadvertently loaded dental rates incorrectly, resulting in underpayments and overpayments for certain dental procedure codes on claims submitted between March 19, 2010, and April 15, 2010.

HP will mass adjust underpaid claims for the following procedure codes:

- D5110 – *Complete Upper Denture, Age 0-20*
- D5110 – *Complete Upper Denture, Age 21-999*
- D5120 – *Complete Lower Denture, Age 21-999*
- D5211 – *Upper Partial-Acrylic Base, Age 0-20*
- D5212 – *Lower Partial-Acrylic Base, Age 0-20*
- D5212 – *Lower Partial-Acrylic Base, Age 21-999*

In addition, HP will mass adjust overpaid claims for the following procedure code:

- D5211 – *Upper Partial-Acrylic Base, Age 21-999*

These mass adjustments will appear on the provider's Remittance Advice (RA) statement beginning May 25, 2010.
