MHQAC utilization edits

On June 19, 2007, the Mental Health Quality Advisory Committee's (MHQAC's) recommended utilization edits for mental health medications were implemented (refer to provider bulletin [BT200709](#), dated May 3, 2007) by the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP). Utilization edits are reviewed quarterly, and the updates in the table below are effective July 19, 2010. These updates were approved at the Quarter Two 2010 MHQAC meeting and at the May 2010 Drug Utilization Review (DUR) Board meeting.

Updates to MHQAC utilization edits

Name and strength of medication	Utilization edit
Focalin XR 30mg (new strength)	1/day
Focalin XR 15mg (revision of edit)	1/day

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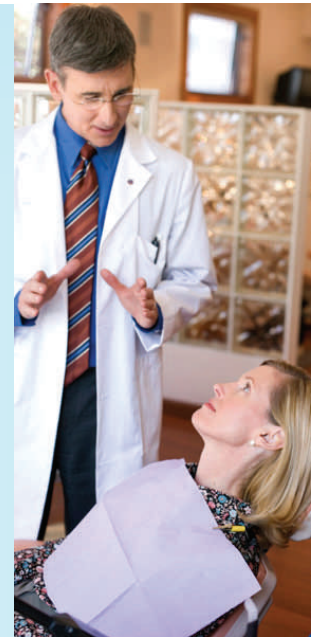
