## Clarification of HIP reimbursement

The Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) has created a new [HIP Reimbursement Manual](#) to assist providers and clarify 405 IAC 9-2-23 – Plan reimbursement rate.

HIP anticipates that Medicare changes will continue to have an impact on this manual. HIP will follow Medicare's guidance for the following:

- The effective date of any reimbursement changes

- If Medicare holds claims, HIP will follow suit.

- If Medicare makes a change in payment effective date retroactive, HIP will also make the effective date retroactive. If Medicare does not make a change in payment effective date retroactive, HIP will not make the effective date retroactive.

## Changes to CPT Codes 66982, 66983, and 66984

Effective December 15, 2010, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will make reimbursement changes to the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT®<sup>1</sup>) codes listed below when billed on the CMS-1500 medical claim form. HP Enterprise Services will adopt the 2010 relative value units (RVUs) from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) Web site for these procedure codes.

### *Changes to CPT codes*

CPT code	Description	New rate
66982*	Extracapsular cataract removal with insertion of intraocular lens prosthesis (one stage procedure), manual or mechanical technique (e.g., irrigation and aspiration or phacoemulsification), complex, requiring devices or techniques not generally used in routine cataract surgery	\$767.69
66983	Intracapsular cataract extraction with insertion of intraocular lens prosthesis (one stage procedure)	\$527.74
66984	Extracapsular cataract removal with insertion of intraocular lens prosthesis (one stage procedure), manual or mechanical technique	\$550.51

\* Procedure code 66982 will also remove the site-of-service indicator from the resource-based relative value scale (RBRVS) pricing logic, eliminating reduction in payment.
