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Using modifiers with codes having professional and technical components

Please note that some codes have professional and technical components. When submitting claims, the modifier you use depends on the component being reported:

- Professional services only – bill with modifier 26 added to the code
- Technical component only – bill with the TC modifier added to the code
- Professional and technical components reported by a single entity as a global code – bill without any modifier

Revenue code 636 linked to HCPCS code J2185

Effective November 4, 2011, the physician-administered Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) drug code J2185 – *Injection, meropenem, 100 mg* has been linked to revenue code 636 – *Drugs requiring detailed coding*.

Providers must bill the procedure code and the revenue code together for dates of service on or after November 4, 2011.

The ISDH has updated CLIA codes

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has reviewed and updated the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) codes to ensure that all CLIA tables comply with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) recommendations. The CLIA tables will continue to be reviewed on an ongoing basis.
