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Extra! Extra! Web interChange can make life easier for Medicaid billers!

Spending too much time on the telephone getting claim status information? Not using Web interChange? Begin today – FREE. Web interChange users can obtain claim status and submit claims, including secondary claims, claim attachments, and Medicare replacement claims.

Already using a software vendor to send claims? No problem – Web interChange users can resubmit claims that require corrections.

Depending on their provider specialty, security clearance, and other factors, providers can use Web interChange to send claim transactions online in a Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) format. Providers using Web interChange can also:

- Verify or update their provider profiles – without using paper forms
- Review past payment information and download weekly Remittance Advices
- Verify the status of members' eligibility for Medicaid benefits
- Get paid – Submit new claims and correct previously submitted claims

CPT code 44135 linked to modifiers 80, 81, and AS

Effective February 1, 2012, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has linked Current Procedural Terminology (CPT^{®1}) code 44135 – *Intestinal allotransplantation; from cadaver donor* to modifiers AS – *Physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or clinical nurse specialist services for assistant at surgery*, 80 – *Assistant Surgeon*, and 81 – *Minimum Assistant Surgeon*. **The linkage will be retroactive to dates of service on or after January 1, 2001.** For reimbursement, you must bill the procedure code and the modifier together.

Providers with claims for dates of service on or between January 1, 2001, and January 31, 2012, which denied with error code 4033 – *Invalid procedure code modifier combination* may resubmit those claims. For claims past the timely filing deadline, providers must resubmit claims with a copy of this banner article for proof of timely filing.

CPT code 83516 linked to revenue code 300

Effective February 1, 2012, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has linked Current Procedural Terminology (CPT^{®1}) code 83516 – *Immunoassay for analyte other than infectious agent antibody or infectious agent antigen; qualitative or semiquantitative, multiple step method* to revenue code 300 – *Laboratory* for dates of service on or after February 1, 2012. For reimbursement, you must bill the procedure code and the revenue code together.
