

Resubmitting NCPDP pharmacy claims for adjustment

Some pharmacy providers have been switching back to the National Council for Prescription Drug Programs (NCPDP) version 5.1 when resubmitting claims for adjustment, believing that if the original claim was submitted in NCPDP version 5.1, the adjustment also needs to be submitted in version 5.1. This is NOT accurate. All claims, including adjustments to claims originally submitted in version 5.1, should be submitted in NCPDP version D.0 format. Going forward, there is no reason to submit claims in NCPDP version 5.1.
