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## HIPAA 5010 billing requirements apply to paper claims

The *Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act* (HIPAA) ASC X12 version 5010 outlined billing requirements that apply to Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) 837 Professional (837P) Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) transactions. The IHCP will also apply these billing requirements to paper and Web interChange claim submissions.

Effective May 21, 2012, for CMS-1500 claims submitted via paper, the qualifiers “PXC” for taxonomy and “G2” for Legacy Provider Identifier (LPI) are accepted. The qualifiers “ZZ” for taxonomy and “1D” for LPI continue to be accepted after May 21, 2012. The taxonomy qualifier for UB-04 claims continues to be “B3.” A qualifier is required when entering the IHCP LPI or a taxonomy code.

The affected fields on the CMS-1500 Claim Form are Fields 17a, 24l, and 33b – Qualifier for taxonomy and LPI (referring, rendering, and billing provider numbers).

**Please note:** A taxonomy code may be needed to establish a one-to-one National Provider Identifier (NPI)/LPI match if the provider has multiple locations. Atypical providers must continue billing with the LPI. The IHCP encourages all waiver providers with both NPIs and LPIs to bill using only the LPI.
