CPT code 92540 linked to provider specialty type 200 – Audiologists

Effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2013, Current Procedural Terminology (CPT^{®1}) code 92540 – *Vestibular Evaluation includes spontaneous nystagmus test with eccentric gaze fixation nystagmus, with recording, optokinetic nystagmus, bidirectional foveal and periphera*) will be linked to provider specialty type 200 – Audiologists. For reimbursement, providers must bill the procedure code and the revenue code together for dates of service on or after January 1, 2013. The provider <u>code sets</u> on indianamedicaid.com will be updated to reflect this provider type and procedure code linkage.

Correction of revenue code linkage for HCPCS code A9503

As published in banner page <u>BR201136</u>, dated September 6, 2011, the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code A9503 – *Technetium, Tc-99m medronate, diagnostic, per study dose, up to 30 millicuries* was to be linked to revenue code 343 – *Diagnostic radiopharmaceuticals* for dates of service on or after November 1, 2011. Due to a systems error, this linkage was not made.

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has corrected the mistake. Providers that received denials for error code 520 – *Invalid revenue code/procedure code combination* for dates of service on or after November 1, 2011, for HCPCS code A9503 with revenue code 343 may resubmit their claims for reimbursement consideration.

Do not send fingerprint samples with your provider enrollment packet

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has not yet incorporated criminal background checks into its provider enrollment process. At this time, providers do not need to submit fingerprint samples with their enrollment packets. The IHCP will provide information to affected entities about how to initiate fingerprinting and criminal background checks at a later date.



Please use current versions of provider enrollment forms

Ten percent of all provider enrollment and maintenance forms submitted are returned to providers due to errors. One common error is using outdated versions of enrollment forms. The enrollment forms are updated periodically and are available on the Complete an IHCP Provider Packet page at indianamedicaid.com. You can be certain you are using the most current version of a form by downloading it from indianamedicaid.com. Avoid reusing previously saved versions of the enrollment forms, which may be outdated.
