Hospital outpatient claims will be mass adjusted or reprocessed

A system error caused inappropriate denial of some outpatient claims billed using the following revenue codes with dates of service (DOS) from January 1, 2013, through January 23, 2013, inclusive:

- 450 – Emergency room
- 510 – Clinic
- 760 – Treatment or observation room
- 761 – Treatment room

These claims incorrectly denied for explanation of benefits (EOB) code 0389 – *Revenue code submitted requires a corresponding HCPCS code*. The system error has been corrected and all outpatient claims billed on or after January 24, 2013, will reimburse appropriately according to policy. The inappropriately denied claims with DOS from January 1, 2013,

through January 23, 2013, will be mass adjusted or reprocessed. Adjustments will begin appearing on the February 19, 2013, Remittance Advice (RA) and will be identified with internal control numbers that begin with region code 80 (reprocess) or 56 (adjustment).
