# The IHCP rates for clinical laboratory services adjusted based on 2014 Medicare rates

Pursuant to Section 1903(i)(7) of the Social Security Act, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has adopted the 2014 Medicare rates for clinical laboratory procedure codes when the IHCP's previous reimbursement rate exceeded the 2014 Medicare rate. As announced in IHCP Banner Page <u>BR201348</u>, the rate changes were effective for dates of service on or after January 1, 2014. The updated rates are reflected in the <u>Fee Schedule</u> at indianamedicaid.com.

# Date changed to May 1 for submission of EP meaningful use attestations

Indiana will begin accepting Program Year 2014 meaningful use (MU) attestations for eligible professionals (EPs) May 1, 2014, rather than April 17, 2014, as originally announced in *Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) Banner page BR201407*. The Medical Assistance Provider Incentive Repository (MAPIR) is scheduled to be upgraded to comply with Program Year 2014 changes, and this upgrade will be completed by May 1, 2014. To ensure that the upgrade has been completed, please do not submit your attestation until May 1, 2014, or after.

Any EP Program Year 2014 attestation started in MAPIR before the upgrade is complete will be aborted and will have to be restarted after the system upgrade. Please note that for meaningful use, all Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) providers will have a 90-day reporting period within the calendar year for Program Year 2014.
