The FSSA revises provider certification for Aged and Disabled and Traumatic Brain Injury waivers

Effective July 14, 2014, the Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) will update the provider certification contact information for the Division of Aging (DA) Home and Community-Based Services (HBCS) waiver programs. Providers requesting information regarding certification under the Aged and Disabled (A&D) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) waivers will be required to contact the Waiver/Provider Analyst using the following contact information. Prospective applicants and current providers should submit certification applications, updates, or terminations to the addresses provided.

In addition, beginning July 14, 2014, a revised application for provider certification will be available on the DA's [Medicaid Waivers](#) web page at in.gov/fssa. To eliminate duplication, the provider application has been streamlined from five pages to one. The revised application is an interactive document that can be completed electronically. Prospective applicants are encouraged to submit application packets via email; however, paper applications will continue to be accepted. A table allowing prospective providers to view services and required documentation will also be available on the DA's Medicaid Waivers web page to assist in the application process.
