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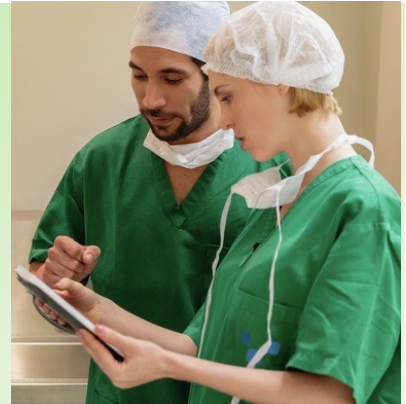
## ASC pricing indicators assigned to multiple CPT codes

Effective April 1, 2015, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has assigned ambulatory surgical center (ASC) pricing indicators to the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT<sup>®1</sup>) codes in [Table 1](#), as noted. The IHCP will reimburse these codes as outpatient services retroactively for dates of service (DOS) on or after **July 1, 2014**.

Beginning April 1, 2015, claims for DOS on or after July 1, 2014, that denied for explanation of benefit (EOB) 4108 – *Claim is being denied. There is no ASC on file for this procedure code*. Please verify that the appropriate outpatient surgery code was billed may be resubmitted for reimbursement consideration. All claims beyond the one-year filing limit must include a copy of this banner page as an attachment and must be filed within one year of the publication date.

These changes will be reflected in the next monthly update to the [Fee Schedule](#) at indianamedicaid.com. The rates associated with the ASC pricing indicator noted can be found on the Fee Schedule under ASC Codes.

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## CPT codes linked to revenue codes effective April 1, 2015

Effective April 1, 2015, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will link the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) code listed in [Table 2](#) to one or more of the following revenue codes, as indicated:

- Revenue code 360 – *Operating Room Services-General*
- Revenue code 490 – *Ambulatory Surgical Care-General*

These linkages apply retroactively to fee-for-service claims with dates of service (DOS) on or after **July 1, 2014**.

Beginning April 1, 2015, providers may bill the CPT codes and the designated revenue codes together for reimbursement consideration, as appropriate. Claims with DOS on or after July 1, 2014, that previously denied for explanation of benefits (EOB) 520 – *Invalid revenue code and procedure code combination* may be resubmitted. All claims beyond the one-year filing limit must include a copy of this banner page as an attachment and must be filed within one year of the publication date.

## ASC pricing indicators removed from multiple procedure codes

Effective April 1, 2015, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has removed the ambulatory surgical center (ASC) pricing indicators from the procedure codes listed in [Table 3](#). These procedure codes fall into one of several categories:

- Codes are listed as reimbursable only in the inpatient setting by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).
- Codes are bundled with the reimbursement for other services.
- Codes are not covered by IHCP.
- Codes are not surgeries.

The IHCP does not recognize these codes as reimbursable in the outpatient setting via the ASC methodology, and as such, the ASC indicators are being removed from the codes. These changes apply to fee-for-service claims with dates of service on or after April 1, 2015.

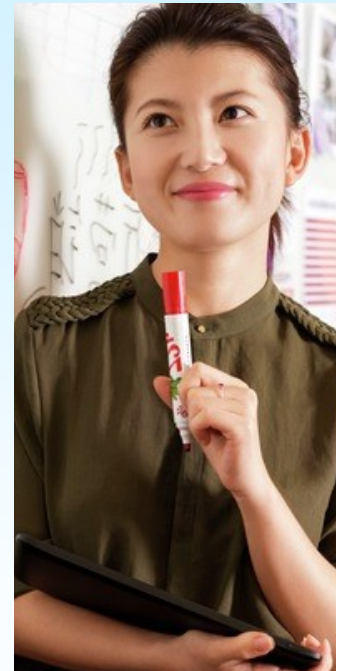
## Provider workshops scheduled for March 2015
