# Member RIDs change for newly eligible members

As the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) moves to a new eligibility system, a new numbering sequence is being used for member identification numbers (RIDs). Beginning July 17, 2016, RIDs issued to newly eligible members include a "120" prefix rather than a "100" prefix. New RIDs continue to follow the same 12-digit format of 12xxxxxxxxy99. All previously assigned "100" RIDs remain intact. Presumptive Eligibility RIDs are also unaffected.

The change in RIDs is a preliminary step in the process of replacing the State's current eligibility system, *Indiana Client Eligibility System* (ICES), with the new *Indiana Eligibility Determination Services System* (IEDSS). The eligibility system is used by the FSSA's Department of Family Resources (DFR) to assist with the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) member application and eligibility determination process. Beginning March 1, 2017, IEDSS will be implemented incrementally, by region. Watch future IHCP publications for additional information about this transition.

# Chiropractic Code Set to be updated

Effective September 15, 2016, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will update the Chiropractic Code Set to add procedure codes for the laboratory services listed in Table 1. These changes apply to dates of service (DOS) on or after September 15, 2016.

Table 1 – Procedure codes added to the Chiropractic Code Set effective for DOS on or after September 15, 2016

Procedure Code	Description
81001	Urinalysis, by dip stick or tablet reagent for bilirubin, glucose, hemoglobin, ketones, leukocytes, nitrite, pH, protein, specific gravity, urobilinogen, any number of these constituents; automated, with microscopy
81002	Urinalysis, by dip stick or tablet reagent for bilirubin, glucose, hemoglobin, ketones, leukocytes, nitrite, pH, protein, specific gravity, urobilinogen, any number of these constituents; non-automated, without microscopy
81025	Urine pregnancy test, by visual color comparison methods
82962	Glucose blood, by glucose monitoring devices(s) cleared by FDA specifically for home use
83026	Hemoglobin; by copper sulfate method, non-automated
85013	Blood count; spun microhematocrit
85651	Sedimentation rate, erythrocyte; non-automated
85652	Sedimentation rate, erythrocyte; automated

These changes will be reflected in the tables posted under Chiropractic Services Codes on the Code Sets page at indianamedicaid.com and in future updates to the Medical Policy Manual and the Chiropractic Services provider reference module.
