## T0: Indiana Medicaid Providers Using the OMNI 380 Terminal To Verify Eligibility SUBJ ECT: C hange in Telephone Number Used To Verify Eligibility

## Important Notice

EDS would like to inform M edicaid providers of a change in the telephone number used to dial in for eligibility verification of Indiana M edicaid recipients. The purpose of this change is to bring quicker, more efficient service to providers. This change will affect some providers using the OM NI 380 swipe card terminal. To determine if you need to make this change, please see: Providers Who Cannot Use The New Eligibility Number - below.
The 800 number currently being used will not be discontinued. However, switching to the 950 number will result in improved response time and will reduce traffic on the 800 line resulting in a quicker response time for providers using the 800 number as well. A pplicable providers should make the change within the next 30 days.

## Providers W ho C annot Use The New Eligibility Number

The new telephone number is 9505829, and can be used throughout Indiana and surrounding regions, however, it is not available in all calling areas. Providers using the following area codes and three digit prefixes cannot use the new telephone number. These providers should continue to use 1-800-931-9001 when verifying eligibility.

## Providers W ho Should Use The New Eligibility Number

If your area code and three digit prefix are NOT listed above, please follow the instructions below to reprogram the OMNI 380 terminal with the new telephone number:

- Press CLEAR - The display will read WELCOMETO INAIM
- Press the number 7 key - The display will read MAINTENANCE
- Press the Blue Enter Key - The display will read SET DATE / TIME
- Press the Blue Enter K ey - The display will read Y or N
- Press the NO key (the \# sign) - The display will read PROV KEY CHANGE
- Press the Blue Enter Key - The display will read Y or N
- Press the NO key (the \#sign) - The display will read RETRY PRINTER
- Press the Blue Enter Key - The display will read Y or N
- Press the No key (the \#sign) - The display will read CHANGE CONFIG
- Press the Blue Enter Key - The display will read Y or N
- Press the Y ES key (the * sign) - The display will read \#PH=

The \#PH is the phone number your system is currently utilizing for eligibility verification.
If it reads 9505829 do not make a change. If it reads $1,800,9319001$ make the following change:

- Press the number 8 key - The display will read INPUT \#PH
- Enter 9505829

If the $* Z P=9505829$ do not make a change. If it reads $1,800,9319001$ make the following change:

- Press the number 8 key - The display will read INPUT *ZP
- Enter 9505829
