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Status of fexofenadine

Fexofenadine tablets have been added to the Pediatric and Adult Over the Counter (OTC) Drug Formularies, effective for dates of service on or after March 2, 2012. See the following table for a summary of this change. The status of fexofen-adine on the Preferred Drug List (PDL) remains unchanged.

Drug class	Drug	PDL status	Step edits
Non-sedating Antihistamine	fexofenadine 60mg tablets	Non-preferred	Must have trial and failure on cetirizine and loratadine within the past 90 days
Non-sedating Antihistamine	fexofenadine 180mg tablets	Non-preferred	Must have trial and failure on cetirizine and loratadine within the past 90 days
