## Update: Reduction in reimbursement for nonstateowned ICF/IID and CRF/DD extended

As previously published in Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) *Bulletins* <u>BT201008</u> and <u>BT201124</u>, the IHCP implemented a 3% reduction in reimbursement for nonstate-owned intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID, formerly ICF/MR) and community residential facilities for the developmentally disabled (CRF/DD) services effective April 1, 2010, through June 30, 2013. This reimbursement reduction will be extended to services with "from" dates of service through December 31, 2013. Further, for claims with "from" dates of service on or after January 1, 2014, the IHCP will implement a 1% reduction in reimbursement for nonstate-owned ICF/IID and CRF/DD services. The July 1, 2013, proposed rates, with the 3% reduction and the January 1, 2014, proposed rates with the 1% reduction, are currently available on the Public Notices page of the website of the state's rate -setting contractor, Myers and Stauffer LC, at in.mslc.com.

Reimbursement for nonstate-owned ICF/IID and CRF/DD services with a "from" date of service on or after April 1, 2010, through December 31, 2013, will be reduced by 3%. Notifications will be sent to each provider by Myers and Stauffer that will include the reduced facility *per diem* rate effective April 1, 2010. All subsequent facility rate adjustments with effective dates on or after April 1, 2010, through December 31, 2013, will likewise be reduced by 3%. Additionally, reimbursement for nonstate-owned ICF/IID and CRF/DD services with a "from" date of service on or after January 1, 2014, will be reduced by 1%. Notifications will be sent to each provider by Myers and Stauffer that will include the reduced facility *per diem* rate effective January 1, 2014. All subsequent facility rate adjustments with effective dates on or after January 1, 2014, will likewise be reduced by 1%.
