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## The IHCP updates list of hospital-acquired conditions

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) follows the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) determinations for hospital-acquired conditions (HACs), which will not be considered for payment if the diagnoses were not present on admission (POA), as well as for the diagnosis codes exempted from POA reporting. The CMS final rule containing the updates to the HAC diagnoses for federal fiscal year (FFY) 2014 was published in the *Federal Register* August 19, 2013. No changes were made to the diagnosis codes exempted from POA reporting for FFY 2014.

The IHCP has updated the list of HACs to comply with the federally defined list. Table 1 identifies the diagnosis codes and diagnosis-procedure code combinations of HACs effective October 1, 2013.
