Money Follows the Person-Community Integration and Habilitation program approved

The Money Follows the Person (MFP) program is funded through a federal grant from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). Indiana's MFP program is specifically designed as a transition program to assist individuals who live in qualifying institutions to move safely into the community and to ensure a safe adjustment to community living.

The CMS has approved the use of MFP funds to establish a Money Follows the Person-Community Integration and Habilitation (MFP-CIH) program. The MFP-CIH program serves individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities that meet eligibility and Level of Care (LOC) requirements.

Effective October 1, 2014, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs will implement the MFP-CIH Program. Providers currently enrolled as CIH providers will be automatically enrolled as MFP-CIH providers. Enrolled providers do not need to take any action in that regard. For more information about MFP services, see the *Money Follows the Person* webpage at in.gov.
