

IHCP corrects CHIP durable medical equipment limitation policy

Effective October 9, 2014, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) will no longer include medical supplies in the \$2,000 annual or \$5,000 lifetime durable medical equipment (DME) limitation for members receiving Package C coverage under the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). This policy correction applies only to Package C coverage for dates of service on or after October 9, 2014.

Indiana Administrative Code (IAC) 407 IAC 3-6-1 specifies that within the CHIP program, DME is subject to a maximum benefit of \$2,000 per calendar year per member and \$5,000 per member



per lifetime. IAC does not reference the inclusion of medical supplies within the limitations. Definitions of DME and medical supplies can be found in 405 IAC 5-19-2 and 405 IAC 5-19-1 respectively.
