IHCP to add diagnosis codes for coverage of visual evoked potential

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) restricts coverage of Current Procedural Terminology (CPT^{®1}) code 95930 – *Visual evoked potential (VEP) testing central nervous system, checkerboard or flash* to specific diagnosis codes when the service is billed by provider specialty 180 – Optometrists. Effective October 1, 2015, the IHCP is expanding the list of diagnosis codes for VEP coverage to include the ICD-10 diagnosis codes listed in Table 1. An ICD-10 crosswalk of the current ICD-9 diagnosis codes for VEP coverage is provided in Table 2.

The ICD-10 diagnosis codes in Tables 1 and 2 may be billed for dates of service (DOS) on or after October 1, 2015. Please note that providers are responsible for billing the appropriate code with the highest level of specificity for the member's diagnosis.

Table 1 – ICD-10 diagnosis codes added for VEP coverage when billed by optometrists effective October 1, 2015

ICD-10 Code	Description
F44.6	Conversion disorder with sensory symptom or deficit
F44.7	Conversion Disorder with mixed symptom presentation
H46.3	Toxic optic neuropathy
H46.9	Unspecified optic neuritis
H47.011	Ischemic optic neuropathy, right eye
H47.012	Ischemic optic neuropathy, left eye
H47.013	Ischemic optic neuropathy, bilateral
H47.019	Ischemic optic neuropathy, unspecified eye

Table 2 – ICD-10 crosswalk of current ICD-9 diagnosis codes for VEP coverage when billed by optometrists

ICD-10 Code	Description
G35	Multiple sclerosis
H53.40	Unspecified visual field defects
Z82.0	Family history of epilepsy and other diseases of the nervous system

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
