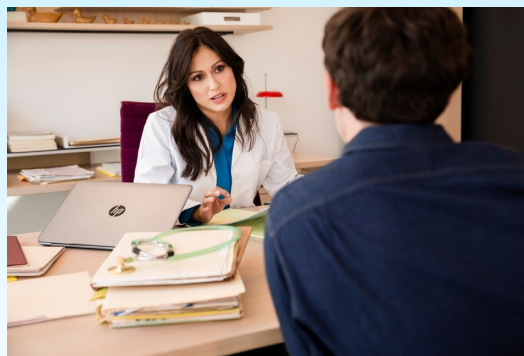

Mental health diagnosis codes for AMHH eligibility cross walked to ICD-10

Adult Mental Health Habilitation (AMHH) services are indicated as a service alternative for members who have achieved maximum benefit from Medicaid Rehabilitation Option (MRO) services and whose needs can better be met through habilitation. Possible candidates for AMHH services are members who are in a home or community-based setting and who have reached their capacity for improving their level of functioning but need to retain their current functional level to remain in that setting. AMHH services are targeted for members who meet the target group criteria, which include an AMHH-eligible primary mental health diagnosis. The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) has cross walked diagnosis codes for AMHH eligibility to ICD-10. A member must have at least one qualifying diagnosis to be eligible for AMHH services.
