## IHCP expands age eligibility for coverage of continuous glucose monitors

The Indiana Health Coverage Programs (IHCP) currently covers continuous glucose monitors for adults and children, age seven and above, for both short-term and long-term use when considered medically necessary. Effective August 1, 2016, the IHCP will expand coverage of continuous glucose monitors to members of all ages. This expanded coverage applies to dates of service (DOS) on or after August 1, 2016, for all IHCP programs, subject to limitations established for certain benefit packages.

All members must meet the coverage and prior authorization criteria outlined in the [Medical Policy Manual](#).

The device used must be approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for use with children in the age range appropriate for the member.

Reimbursement, prior authorization (PA), and billing information apply to services delivered under the fee-for-service (FFS) delivery system. Questions about FFS PA should be directed to Cooperative Managed Care Services (CMCS) at 1-800-269-5720. Individual managed care entities (MCEs) establish and publish reimbursement, PA, and billing criteria within the managed care delivery system. Questions about managed care should be directed to the MCE with which the member is enrolled.

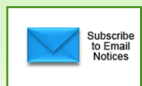
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
