Amendments approved for CIH and FSW programs

Effective September 1, 2016, the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) received approval of amendments to the Community Integration and Habilitation (CIH) Waiver and Family Supports Waiver (FSW) programs from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). Both programs are 1915(c) Medicaid waivers that provide home and community-based services (HCBS) to persons with intellectual disabilities or related conditions residing in a range of community settings as an alternative to care in an intermediate care facility or other institution.



The approved amendments allow federal support for rate increases put in place by the Division of Disability and Rehabilitative Services (DDRS) effective July 1, 2016, as outlined in Table 1. Because claims have been paying at the increased rates for dates of service (DOS) on or after July 1, 2016, approval of the amendment will require no claim adjustments.

Residential habilitation and supports (hourly and daily)	2.5%
Facility-based habilitation – Individual	2.5%
Respite	2.5%
Case management	5.0%
Family Supports Waiver	
Community-based habilitation – Individual	2.5%
Facility-based habilitation – Individual	2.5%
Respite	2.5%
