FSSA announces CMS approval of TBI Waiver renewal

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) has received approval from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) for renewal of the Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) Waiver. The approved effective date of the renewal is January 1, 2018.

Renewal of the TBI Waiver allows the Division of Aging (DA) and Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning (OMPP) to continue providing home and community-based services to individuals who would require institutional care if these services were not provided. The goal of the TBI Waiver is to ensure that individuals who have suffered a traumatic brain injury receive appropriate services based on their needs and the needs of their families.

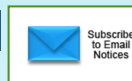
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
